PUBLIC SKATING RULES OF CONDUCT:

- No food or drink on the ice surface.
- No horseplay/games.
- Skate only as fast as the general flow of skaters.
- No balls/pucks/chairs/pylons/strollers/ stick or any other item which might interfere with the safety of any skater while on the ice.
- No carrying of children is to be permitted.
- Skate with the direction of all skaters.
- Listen and adhere to the Skate Patrol at all times.
- Consider the use of a helmet as they are strongly recommended.
- Those with little or no skating experience should stay in the centre ice area.
