TIPS

- Weather during the spring months can be very chilly and wet at times. Bring layers, such as long-sleeved shirts, thick pants, warm socks, sweaters, and toward the end of spring, substitute your winter jacket for a medium-weight jacket. It's wise to have raingear, water-repellent footwear and an umbrella for Grey County's spring showers.
- The fruit trees in Grey County can blossom any time between late April to mid May. The apple tree's blossom period has been known to change from year to year and has also been as short as only 1 or 2 weeks long so be sure to check ahead of time with the local producers.
